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

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1. General provisions

1.1. These Regulations determine the status, goals and objectives of the International Olympiad among applicants of NJSC "Narxoz University" (hereinafter referred to as the "International Olympiad") and the procedure for its holding.

1.2. Participants of the International Olympiad are notified of the cancellation or amendment of the terms of the Regulation no later than one working day from the date of their entry into force by posting information on the official website of the University and in the University's social media accounts.

1.3. Educational benefits awarded on the basis of the results of the International Olympiad do not apply to joint educational programs of NJSC Narxoz University (hereinafter referred to as the "University") implemented by the University jointly with other educational organizations.

1.4. The working languages of the International Olympiad are Kazakh, Russian and English.

1.5. The conditions of the International Olympiad will be available on official social networks and on the university website.

2. Basic goals International Olympics

2.1. Through the International Olympiad, the University seeks to motivate graduate students of general educational institutions and lyceums (hereinafter referred to as "students"):

- to the development of critical and creative thinking;
- to the identification and development of students' creative abilities and interest in knowledge in the field of the chosen educational program;
- to share knowledge with other students with similar interests and areas of study;
- development of internationalization at Narxoz University;
- attracting talented youth;
- providing equal opportunities for everyone who wants to get an education in Kazakhstan.

3. Participants of the International Olympics

3.1. Graduates of foreign schools/gymnasiums/lyceums/colleges in 2023 can take part in the International Olympiad .

3.2. Required documentation:

– a copy of an identity document, consent to the processing of personal data, as well as permission to publish works, photographs, videos on the official website of the University, in the University's social media accounts, and promotional materials of the University .

– for persons under the age of 18, a copy of the identity document of the parent (legal representative), his consent to the processing of his personal data and the child, as well as permission to publish works, photos, videos of the child on the official website of the University, in the University's accounts in social networks, promotional materials of the University.

4. Organizational and methodological regulations, expert and competitive commissions.

4.1. For organizational and methodological regulations of the International Olympiad, an organizational Committee.

The composition of the organizing committee is formed from among the employees of the Department recruiting . Head of the organizing committee Division recruiting and admissions.

The organizing committee solves the following tasks:

- ensures the organization and holding of all events within the framework of International Olympiad;
- submits a report on the work;
- develops tasks for the International Olympiad in accordance with the theme, goals and objectives of the International Olympiad;
- draws up a statement results;
- performs other functions in accordance with the Regulations.

4.5. To evaluate the competitive works of participants International Olympiad, an expert commission is being created. The expert commission for holding the International Olympiad includes experts from among the representatives of the University schools. The organizing committee is headed by the Center for Interdisciplinary Education . The number of members of the expert committee should be odd.

Members of the Expert Commission should not be affiliated with the participants of the International Olympiad. In the event that the facts of affiliation of the members of the Expert Commission with the participants of the International Olympiad are established, these members must be suspended from work as part of the Expert Commission. In case of concealment of the fact of affiliation, a member of the Expert Commission may be held liable, including for compensation for damage caused to the University.

The committee of experts selects a responsible person from among its members. secretary.

Competence of the expert commissions:

- determines the winners of the International Olympiad;
- evaluates work participants International Olympiad;
- in a timely manner provides results Organizing Committee ;
- announces the results of the International Olympiad and winners;
- considers applications and complaints against the actions of the Organizing Committee International Olympiad;
- performs other functions in accordance with the Regulations.

The decision of the Expert Commission is not subject to appeal subject to.

4.6. For holding the 2nd round of the International Olympiad competition committee .

Composition of the Competition the commission is formed from among the employees of the Department recruiting and admissions, department international development and partnership. Heads the competitive commissib Provost university .

The competition commission selects a responsible person from among its members secretary.

Competition competence commissions:

- determines the winners of the International Olympiad;
- announces the results of the International Olympiad and winners;
- considers applications and complaints against the actions of the Organizing Committee International Olympiad;
- performs other functions in accordance with the Regulations.

5. Holding the International Olympiad

5.1. The International Olympiad is held in 2 stages:

1. Writing an essay in three languages of your choice (English, Kazakh, Russian);

Essay submission deadlines 1 April 5 - 30 , 2023, works are accepted on the Olympiad website <https://zh.narxoz.kz/>

Topics for writing an essay (to choose from in 3 languages):

— The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?

— Describe a problem you've solved or a problem you'd like to solve. It can be an intellectual challenge, a research query, an ethical dilemma - anything of personal importance, no matter the scale. Explain its significance to you and what steps you took or could be taken to identify a solution.

— Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.

— When you choose a university, you join a new community of people who have different backgrounds, experiences, and stories. What is it about your background and your experiences that will enrich Narxoz University's community?

— Tell us about a place or community you call home. How has it shaped your perspective?

— Please briefly elaborate on one of your extracurricular activities or work experiences that was particularly meaningful to you.

2. 70 % of participants who scored highest scores for evaluation essay pass interview with members competitive commissions. The interview will allow you to assess how this applicant is ready to study at our university and whether he is sufficiently motivated.

Evaluation criteria:

— The level of motivation, awareness of the choice of the educational program, argumentation;

— The level of theoretical (basic) knowledge and achievements in studies and / or in the field of the chosen educational program;

— Logic of reasoning and quality of speech, personal qualities, skills in solving situational problems;

Terms of the stages of the Competition: 1 round - 15 - 30 April 2023; Round 2 - May 10 -15 , 2023.

6. Summing up and awarding participants

6.1. Based on the results of the International Olympiad, the Competition Commission forms a protocol decision of the Competition Commission on awarding the winners of the International Olympiad with certificates for obtaining an educational privileges at the University .

6.2. Quantity educational benefits determined by the authorized body or official of the University.

6.3. An educational benefit is provided to graduates who have completed their studies in foreign educational organizations that have won the International Olympics upon confirmation grade point average with a certificate of completion of secondary education with a grade of at least "good".

6.4. To receive an educational benefit , the winners of the International Olympiad must apply

to the University Admissions Committee with a certificate for educational benefits and other documents necessary for admission and admission to the University before August 10 of the calendar year. The decision of the Contest Commission and documents confirming training in foreign educational organizations are submitted to the Commission for the Provision of Educational Benefits (hereinafter referred to as the "Commission for Benefits"). The Benefits Commission reviews the submitted documents and makes a decision to grant or, in the event of an incomplete package of documents, to refuse to grant educational benefits. The decision of the Benefits Commission is subject to approval by the University Board. Based on the decision of the Board of the University, the winners of the International Olympiad are provided with educational benefits and a corresponding additional agreement is concluded with them to the contract for the provision of educational services.

6.5. In case of violation of the deadline for submitting a certificate for receiving educational benefits and other documents required for admission and enrollment in the University Admissions Committee (clause 6.4 of the Regulations), the certificate for receiving educational benefits is canceled.

Funding for education within the framework of the provided educational benefits is maintained if the grantees successfully pass the current session and maintain a GPA of at least 3.0 at the end of each academic period, the absence of academic debt, violations of the requirements of the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the Code of Ethical Conduct and / or other internal documents of the University. When calculating the GPA, data for the summer semester is not taken into account. The exception is cases when a student was on academic leave due to illness, pregnancy and childbirth, academic mobility, in connection with conscription for military service in the Armed Forces of the Republic of Kazakhstan. The grant is provided for the entire period of study, while the review of the grant is carried out every academic year (fall and spring semesters) by the Commission on Benefits. In case of non-compliance with the requirements established by this paragraph, the Benefits Commission decides to deprive the student of educational benefits for the remaining period of study without the right to restore it. The educational benefit is not lost when changing the educational program. In case of changing the educational program to double degree programs, it is necessary to pay extra for the component of the partner university.

6.6. The educational benefit does not apply to academic debt payments.

Compliance with the specified criteria for this category of persons is checked and confirmed by the Office of the Registrar of the University, in case of a decrease in academic performance, the information is transferred to the Benefits Commission to make a decision on the deprivation of educational benefits for the remaining period of study.

6.7. A student for the entire period of study at the University (during ten academic months from September to June) subject to the conditions specified in clause 6.6. of this Regulation, receives a scholarship in the amount of 36,600 (thirty six thousand six hundred) tenge, excluding taxes.

7. Responsibility

7.1 The organizers are not responsible for non-fulfillment, as well as untimely fulfillment by the participants of the conditions of the International Olympiad, provided for by the Regulations.

7.2 The Organizers are not responsible for the fact that the Participant has not read the terms of participation in the International Olympiad.

7.3 The Organizers are not responsible for receiving from the Participants incomplete and/or incorrect contact and/or other information necessary for the purpose of holding the International Olympiad.

8. Final provisions

8.1 The person responsible for the implementation of the Regulations is the Director of the Department for International Development and Partnership and Head of Recruiting and Admissions.

8.2 The regulation is approved by the decision of the Board of the University .

8.3 Changes and additions to this Regulation are made on the basis of a decision boards University .
